



Do you want to earn concurrent credit while attending high school?

To be eligible for concurrent credit you must qualify!

You must earn a qualifying score on either the **ASSET, ACT, PSAT, SAT, or the MAP Test.**

Eligibility Requirements for Concurrent Credit

Barton Community College

To enroll in any BCCC concurrent enrollment course presently offered at Hays High, a student must

- a) Have a score of at least 18 on the ACT reading subtest.
- b) **OR** have a 40 on the reading skills subtest of the ASSET Exam.

Fort Hays State University

1) To enroll in any FHSU concurrent course except College Algebra, a student must meet ONE of the following criteria:

- a) **Have** a composite score of at least 21 on the ACT or ACT Residual.
- b) **OR** have a combined verbal and mathematical score on the SAT Reasoning Test of at least 1000.
- c) **OR** have a Selection Index (a combined score) on the PSAT/NMSQT of at least 150.
- d) **OR** have a composite score of at least 21 on the PLAN test.
- e) **OR** have a score of 43 or higher on the reading skills subtest of the ASSET and a score of 39 or higher on the numerical skills subtest of the ASSET.
- f) **OR** have a MAP test reading score of at least 227 and mathematics score of at least 239.

2) To enroll in MATH 110, College Algebra, a student must

- a) **Have** scores on the ACT math subtest and the ACT science subtest that combine for a total of 40 or higher, and have at least an 18 on both subtests;
- b) **OR** have a score of at least 15 on the FHSU math placement exam.

BCCC Concurrent Courses

AP American History, 3 cr. hr.

Spanish IV, 5 cr. hr.

Students are limited to accumulating 24 concurrent credit hours prior to graduation.

BCCC Tuition

BCCC concurrent credit tuition is \$87 per credit hour. Therefore, a typical 3-credit hour course will cost \$261.

BCCC BOOST Scholarship

Barton offers the Barton Boost Scholarship to high school students who receive **free or reduced lunches**. Qualifying students are eligible to receive up to six (6) free credit hours of instruction per semester. However, this scholarship doesn't include the cost of books.

FHSU Tuition

FHSU concurrent credit tuition this year is \$178.30 per credit hour. Therefore, a typical 3-credit hour course will cost \$534.90 plus the one-time \$30 FHSU matriculation fee if it has not already been paid.

FHSU PEACE AWARD

Upon successful completion of a course, students paying the above tuition will receive a PEACE Award Scholarship of \$35 per credit hour to be used within a year toward another FHSU course.
