FHSU, BCC and NCK Tech officials will be in the HHS Library from 12:00 – 5:30 pm on August 20 for Juniors and Seniors wishing to enroll in concurrent credit courses. Reps will answer questions regarding the requirements as well as assist qualifying students to enroll in fall concurrent credit courses. The reps will collect tuition or help families create payment plans at that time.

FHSU Fall Concurrent Credit Course Info

Cost: \$194.14 per credit hour (a 3-credit hour course is \$582.42 - all Fall courses are 3-credit hours). There is a \$30 one-time application fee. Payment plans are available.

Scholarships:

FHSU offers PEACE Award Scholarships. Students who enroll in and successfully complete FHSU concurrent courses will receive PEACE Award Scholarships of \$40 per credit hour to be used within a year toward another FHSU course.

Fall FHSU Concurrent Credit Courses:

College Algebra—Srs Only
Fundamentals of Oral Communication
Calculus Methods
Psychology

****FHSU Concurrent Credit Eligibility Requirements:****

1) To enroll in any FHSU concurrent course except College Algebra, a student must meet ONE of the following criteria:

- a) Composite score of at least 21 on the ACT
- b) Combined verbal and mathematical score on the SAT Reasoning Test of at least 1000
- c) A Selection Index (a combined score) on the PSAT/NMSQT of at least 150
- d) A composite score of at least 21 on the PLAN test
- e) A score of 43 or higher on the reading skills subtest of the ASSET and a score of 39 or higher on the numerical skills subtest of the ASSET

****Due to recent test changes, this semester will be a transitional semester for meeting eligibility requirements. More information will follow.****

- 2) To enroll in MATH 110, College Algebra, a student must:
 - a) Have scores on the ACT math subtest and the ACT science subtest that combine for a total of 40 or higher, and have at least an 18 on both subtests;
 - b) OR have a score of at least 15 on the FHSU math placement exam.

BCC Fall Concurrent Credit Course Info

Cost: \$100 per credit hour (a 3-credit hour course is \$300). Payment plans are available.

Scholarships:

Barton offers the Barton Boost Scholarships for up to 6 free credit hours per semester to students who receive free or reduced lunches. The Boost Scholarship does not cover books. **You must have a separate waiver for release of information form on file with the Counseling Office. The form is on the back of this page. Complete and return to the Counseling Office.**

BCC Concurrent Credit Eligibility Requirements:

A test is no longer required for students to enroll in BCC concurrent credit courses. However, students should not enroll in Concurrent Credit unless they have a minimum core grade point average of at least "C".

NCK Tech Fall Concurrent Credit Course Info

Cost: \$131 per credit hour (a 3-credit hour course is \$393). There is a \$50 one-time application fee. Payment plans are available.

Fall NCK Tech Concurrent Credit Course:

Sociology

NCK Tech Concurrent Credit Eligibility Requirements:

A test is not required for students to enroll in the NCK Tech Sociology course. However, students should not enroll in Concurrent Credit unless they have a minimum core grade point average of at least "C".
