- 1. Must be an Ellis, Rush or Trego County High School Graduate**
- 2. Degree in Biology or Agriculture and will attend an accredited university, college, or technical-vocational school in Kansas**
- 3. Must complete scholarship application and essay (Within 500 words- double spaced.)

- 4. Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average.**

Selection and Award of Scholarship

- 1. The Chapter Scholarship Committee will make the selection.**
- 2. The Committee will notify recipient by February 20, 2017**
- 3. Scholarship money will be available at the time of enrollment, and will be sent to the school of choice. One half of the scholarship (\$250.00) will be paid for the fall enrollment and the last half will be paid after the scholarship committee has received a copy of the college fall semester grades. A 2.0 grade point must be maintained.**
- 4. If all criteria are not met, the scholarship will not be awarded.**
